

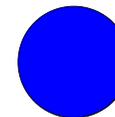

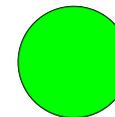

## OTHER NOTES

Weak jump shifts over interference after our openings.

5 level cue bids in competitive auctions asks for 6 if losers can be kept to 1 in that suit.
