## INFORMATION

### **PARKING**

There is ample free parking on Rose Terrace, off Goodwood Road. If you are mobility-impaired, please speak with one of the Convenors (Deb Wellman or Di Marler) to organise a closer alternative.

***You will need to take a ticket each time you enter the Car Park however, once you get a Parking Pass from the Hospitality Desk, you will be able to exit without cost.***

### **CATERING**

There will be a free tea and coffee station in the reception area of the Goyder Mezzanine. Specialist coffee and tea will be available to purchase from the on-site coffee shop.

A variety of lunch and snack foods will also be available for purchase. ***It is advisable to pre-order your lunch, at the till downstairs. There will be a special "BRIDGE" line for collection at lunchtime (given there are also university exams being held).***

The café is open from 9.30am to 4.00pm daily.

### **ACCESS TO THE PLAYING AREA**

Five successive doubles and redoubles (and by a Passed Hand), with each double being of a different suit too! Outcome: 2HX failed by 3 tricks.

## ANOTHER AMUSING AUCTION

During our annual Pairs with an Expert AUCTION 3 occurred:

WEST	NORTH	EAST	SOUTH
1NT	2D (natural)	2NT	3D
3S	Pass	4C	All Pass

Before tabling her hand, dummy said to her expert partner, "You can play this hand as punishment for passing."

The expert partner said that he hadn't been sure what 2NT was, but had concluded that it was most likely Lebensohl. Hence he concluded that 4C was now natural.

Dummy agreed that 2NT was, indeed, Lebensohl but that now 4C was Gerber.

I was still wondering what sort of hand one could have where you were only strong enough to use Lebensohl (therefore non-forcing) rather than 3S natural and forcing, but could now look for slam...

Personally, I would have just bid 4S over 2D, but this made for a far more interesting time at the table.

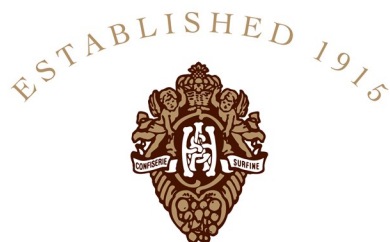
