INFORMATION

PARKING

There is ample free parking on Rose Terrace, off Goodwood Road. If you are mobility-impaired, please speak with one of the Convenors (Deb Wellman or Di Marler) to organise a closer alternative.

3S Pass 4C All Pass

Before tabling her hand, dummy said to her expert partner, "You can play this hand as punishment for passing."

The expert partner said that he hadn't been sure what 2NT was, but had concluded that it was most likely Lebensohl. Hence he concluded that 4C was now natural.

Dummy agreed that 2NT was, indeed, Lebensohl but that now 4C was Gerber.

I was still wondering what sort of hand one could have where you were only strong enough to use Lebensohl (therefore non-forcing) rather than 3S natural and forcing, but could now look for slam...
