

BASIC RESPONSES

Jump raises - minors limit forcing Other: Inverted

Jump raises - majors limit forcing Other: Bergen

Jump shifts after minor opening M = weak. Other m = invitational raise

Jump shifts after major opening Bergen

Responses to strong 2 suit opening 2♦ is negative or waiting, 2NT is minors (xxneg)

Responses to 2NT opening m to play, M is forcing and natural, jump 4m ask for sing



Defence to opening Two's: Multi 2♦ x 13+, 2NT Bal 15 - 18, 2♥ good hand with ♣

RCO style 2-s 2♣ good hand with ♦, 3♣/♦ natural and weak
x opening hand with suit bid, 2nd x t.o., 3rd x penalties

Other 2-s If 2♣/2♦ wk with both majors, then x = opening hand,
2NT 15 - 18, both majors stopped, 2♥/2♠ 15+, stopper show

Defence to strong ♣ x = ♣+♥, ♦ = ♦+♥, ♥ = ♥+♠, 1NT = ♦+♠
2♠ = ♠+♣

Lebensohl Over NT interference

Other uses Over weak 2's. Used by opener over 2 level bid by RHO

Take out of 4 level pre-empts 4♣/4♦ x = t.o.
4♥ x = t.o. 4♠ x = penalties. 4NT 2 suited t.o.

OTHER NOTES

Over strong NT in 3rd seat, Transfers to all suits., 3♣ puppet stayman
Jump to 3♥/3♠ is a splinter. At least 5/4 in minors and shortage in major
