## **Programme**

**Open Pairs:** Commences Sunday Feb 18th at 1.30 p.m.. Two session qualifying. Final commences on Monday Feb 19th at 1.30 p.m. and concludes on Tuesday Feb 20th at about 5 p.m.

**0-149 Pairs:** Runs parallel with the Open Pairs and over the same times. This event is open only to pairs where neither partner has reached 150 MPs as at 30.9.2000.

Both these events will be conducted at the ANA Hotel.

**Open Swiss Teams**: Commences at 8 p.m. on Tuesday Feb. 20th. and continues until Friday Feb 23rd about 5 p.m. The final will be on Vugraph at 8 p.m. on Friday Feb 23rd.

**Seniors and Restricted Swiss Teams:** These are new events, which will run in parallel with the Open Teams with the same session times and similar format. The Seniors Teams will attract playoff points for the ABF selection process for the National Seniors Team

These events will be conducted at the Gold Coast International Hotel, which is situated on the Pacific Highway at a comfortable walking distance from the ANA Hotel. The Seniors Teams is open only to teams all of whose members have attained th age of 55 years by 20.2.01 The Restricted Teams is open only to teams in which each member has less than 300 masterpoints as at 30/9/2000. There will be separate prize lists for these events.

**Walk-in pairs:** 1. **Carinya Welcome Walk-in Pairs:** Saturday Feb 17th at 7 for 7.30 cutoff time. Come for a welcome drink before playing. Entry fees payable at the table.

- 3. ANA Shield. Saturday Feb 24th. Cutoff time 9.30 a.m.

## **FORMAT**

**Open Pairs and 0 - 149 Pairs**: Two qualifying rounds and three session barometer finals. Final sections will be of 14 tables as far as possible.

**Open Teams**: Swiss format, 14 board matches. After 10 matches, qualifying teams will withdraw for semi-finals and finals. The Swiss will continue for the remainder of the field, and will finish by around 5 p.m. on Friday 23rd.

**Seniors and Restricted Teams**: To be played in parallel with the Open Teams. Final format to be determined by numbers.

The QBA reserves the right to vary the format and qualification requirements for teams events depending on the size of the fields and venues required. Any such variation will be announced at the commencement of the event.

#### **GENERAL CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

- 1. Entries must be made using an entry form and forwarding full payment of fees. Note the conditions in the entry form regarding entries without payment.
- 2. The QBA reserves the right to reject entries at its absolute discretion and without assigning a reason. Any rejected entry will be returned as promptly as possible and money refunded. No correspondence or debate will be entered into.
- 3. A minimum of neat casual dress must be observed at all times in the playing area.
- 4. No smoking will be permitted in the defined playing area.
- 5. Entries are open only to ABF registered players and bona fide overseas contestants.
- 6. The ABF System and Alerting Regulations will apply. Players are responsible for ensuring the accuracy of their system classification. If in doubt, submit your system in advance to the Chief Tournament Director. Copies of these regulations will be posted at the venue, as will supplementary regulations.

'System regulations' and 'Alerting regulations' refer to those regulations in force at 31st December 2000

#### SUMMARY OF SYSTEMS REGULATIONS

Open Pairs: GREEN, BLUE and RED systems permitted.

0 - 149 Pairs: GREEN and BLUE systems only.

**Teams:** All systems permitted except that YELLOW systems will not be permitted in the first two matches of the Swiss and thereafter will be limited to the top quarter of the field. Any pair proposing to play a YELLOW system must lodge two copies of their system with the Chief Tournament Director prior to the commencement of the teams events.

**Protected pairs:** Certain pairs may apply for Protected Pair status. This will apply in this tournament only in the Open Pairs. Requirements:

- 1. The pair must be playing a GREEN system.
- 2. Both players must be below the status of National Master OR one player must be below the status of Local Master.
- 3. The pair must apply in advance to the Chief Tournament Director for Protected Pair status. If this is approved they must apply both a GREEN sticker and a BROWN sticker on their system cards. Protected pairs should ascertain at the start of a round whether their opponents are playing a red system in order to claim their protected pair status..
