Jump raises - minors limit forcing Other: Inverted

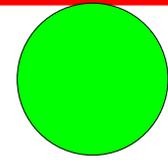

Variable Jump Overcalls (WK/Inter)

COMPETITIVE BIDDING

Negative doubles through 4♥ Responsive doubles through 4♥

Jump overcalls Weak / Inter. Unusual NT Lowest 2 Unbid Suits (5-5)

1NT overcall (immediate) good 15-18 (re-opening) ~ 10-14

Immed cue of minor ♠ + another (5-5), range undefined

Immed cue of major Other major + a minor (5-5), range undefined

Over opponent's 1NT (weak) Canape Transfers see Other Notes

Over opponent's 1NT (strong) Canape Transfers see Other Notes

Over weak twos X = T/O, 4♣ / ♦ = Suit bid + 4 Other Major

Over opening threes X = T/O

4th Suit Forcing One round Game force

NT Checkback Priorities 2-level = min; 2♦ = no M feature

Defence to 3NT opening X = values, others = natural

Defence to opening Two's: Multi 2♦ X = values, 2NT = 16-18, others = natural

RCO style 2-s X = values, 2NT = 16-18, others = natural

Reopening 2NT = 13-15

Other 2-s X = values, 2NT = 16-18, others = natural

Reopening 2NT = 13-15

Defence to strong ♣ X, 1♦/♥/♠ = suit + suit above, 1NT = ♦+♠, 2♣ = ♣+♥

1♣-1♦: X=Values, 1NT=♥+m, 2NT=♣+♦, suit=NAT

Lebensohl Over NT interference

Other uses After our direct X of weak 2 opening

Take out of 4 level pre-empts 4♣/4♦ X

4♥ X, 4NT 4♠ X, 4NT

OTHER NOTES

Rubensohl after interference over our 1NT opening & direct 1NT overcall.

Bourke Relay (3rd suit forcing) if opener makes simple rebid of suit opened.

Exclusion Blackwood & Minorwood

Canape Transfers over opponents' 1NT: 2♣ = ♦ or both M (54) or both m (55);

2♦ = 5+♥ or 5♥+5♦ or 4♥+6 other; 2♥ = 5+♠ or 5♠+5♥ or 4♠+6 other;

2♠ = 55 ♠+minor; 2NT = ♣s; 3♣ = 55 ♣+♥
